The Household Health Survey is a major telephone survey conducted by PHMC— a nonprofit public health agency.

- If you live in Southeastern Pennsylvania your house phone or cell phone may be called to participate!
- The survey starts **June 2010** and runs throughout the summer. Over 10,000 households will be interviewed.
- Participating in the survey is free and all of your responses are confidential.** No one will try to sell you anything.
- The results are used by local public health departments, hospitals, health insurers, universities, and community based nonprofits.
- The survey is supported by many major charitable foundations, local government, and healthcare partners.
